Details of tenders are maintained on publically available websites such as Tenders direct.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How long is this contract to run for? 	<p>The contract commenced across Bristol, North Somerset, South Gloucestershire, Gloucestershire area on the 2nd November 2015. Gloucestershire CGG's initial contract term was 17 months with option of up to 4 years extension. The current</p>

	Gloucestershire CCG contract term is until the 31 st March 2018 with the option for the CCG to exercise further extensions up to 3 years.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What conditions will be treated within this contract? 	The contract is for elective services provided as outpatients, day case or inpatient elective service as well as diagnostics and assessment. This includes Ophthalmology including potential for community Age-related Macular Degeneration/Glaucoma
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where will this contact be delivered from? 	The contract covers Bristol, North Somerset, South Gloucestershire, Gloucestershire area. The provider has not specified the location of services in Gloucestershire. The contract requires the provider to offer an accessible service to the local population in an appropriate clinical setting.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you explain how this contract links with any other contract you may have with both acute and primary care providers. 	Any qualified provider contracts are commissioned to increase patient choice. All providers must meet the qualification criteria set for a particular service and once qualified their service will appear on choose and book for patients to select.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the expected contract value per annum both in terms of activity and finance? 	The contract is a zero based contract, with no guarantee as to any volumes or payments in respect of volumes. All payments will be issued on a payments by results basis, and paid at National Tariff rates (or locally agreed tariffs where no national one exists), as issued by Monitor and NHS England.
