An example of one part of an STP clinical review is attached FYI.</p>	<p>Gloucestershire STP has agreed to deliver whole system transformation using the Clinical Programme Approach. The first stage of the Clinical Programme Approach is a design phase which routinely involves reviewing the current, system-wide clinical services and patient pathways in a view to highlight areas of opportunity to improve the services being delivered. This process includes carrying out service walk-throughs, reviewing clinician’s opinions, reviewing clinical evidence and benchmarking performance against like for like areas.</p> <p>This stage culminates in a set of recommendations for change that are clinically led and driven, from which the transformation process is designed before being delivered. Further detail on the clinical programme approach can be found within the STP plan. Clinical reviews are a fundamental part of all of our transformation.</p>
