This is an absolute exemption.</p> <p>I have provided you with a link to the website which will provide you with this information.</p>

The number of NHS GP surgeries or Primary Care Centres within NHS Gloucestershire CCG currently (most recent data available) located in previously residential class properties.</p> <p>For clarity, I mean how many properties currently in the use class D1 (under 1987 UCO), now E(e) (under 2020 UCO), have been previously classed as C3 (dwellinghouses).</p>	<p>The CCG does not in itself own/lease GP estate. This function is undertaken by the practice's themselves.</p> <p>The CCG does not hold a list of GP premises that includes specific data about classes of building.</p>
